- PhD: normally 4 years

The Dutch grading scale is from 1 (very poor) to 10 (outstanding). The lowest passing grade is 6. A grade of 9 is seldom given and a 10 is extremely rare. The grades 1 - 3 are hardly ever used. - Spring semester: 1 October (15 September for non-EU students)

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Application deadlines

- Fall semester: 25 May (1 May for non-EU students)
- Spring semester: 25 October (1 October for non-EU students)

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The academic year starts in early September and ends in early July.

SEMESTER DIVISION

The academic year is divided into 2 semesters of 19 or 20 teaching weeks. A mandatory introduction program is organised in the week before the start of each semester.

Fall semester

Starts in early September and ends in late January

The semester is divided into two terms:

- Term 1 runs from early September to mid-November
- Term 2 runs from mid-November to late January

Spring semester

Starts early February and ends early July

The semester is divided into two terms:

- Term 3 runs from early February to mid-April
- Term 4 runs from mid-April to early July
