<b>Required documents</b>	You will have to upload following documents to Mobility Online: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Transcript of Records of the last year you finished</li> <li>- Copy of your health insurance card</li> <li>- Proof of language proficiency (English B1)</li> <li>- Copy of your passport or identity card (both sides)</li> <li>- Copy of your student card of your home institution</li> <li>- Passport photograph</li> </ul>
<b>Available Accommodation On Campus</b>	HOGENT offers 40 rooms to incoming exchange students in our Mercator student residence. The sooner students finalize their application and tick the box for these rooms in the online application, the more chance to get one. Note that the rooms are only for semester students. The rooms are allocated to the students as soon as possible after the application deadline (1 May or 15 October).
