## Academic calendar for exchange students

## Language Requirements

For attending lectures in English or German, students need at least B2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Partner universities are in the responsibility of **only nominating students with at least B2** in the language of instruction.

## Workload

According to the guidelines of the European Commission, 60 credits represent the workload of a full year of study; the workload for one semester corresponds to 30 credits.

Credits are awarded only when the module has been completed and all required examinations have been successfully taken. Exchange students can take as many modules as they wish but it is advisable to take no more than 30 – 35 credits.


## Choosing your modules

**Undergraduate students** can choose their modules from any of our Bachelor's programs only. **Postgraduate students** can choose their modules from any of our Bachelor's and Master's programs.

However, all exchange students must fulfill the requirements set by their home institution.

# **Application process**

## Nomination by home institution

Every exchange student has to be officially nominated by the International Office of his/her home institution via our <u>https://hof.moveon4.de/form/622b30d1ce60dc6573236fd1/eng</u>.

Students need to be nominated before the end of our nomination period:

- \_ For winter semester: April 30
- \_ For summer semester: October 31

Afterwards, the nominated students will be informed by us about the application process.

## Application deadlines

Students need to apply before the end of our application period:

- For winter semester: May 31
- \_ For summer semester: November 30

Admission letters will be sent after the application deadline at the latest.

## Required application documents

The following documents are required for an exchange program at Hof University:

- \_ Current academic transcript of records in English language (PDF)
- \_ Passport photo in high resolution (JPG, 300x400)
- \_ Copy of passport or ID Card (for EU citizens) (PDF)
- \_ Letter of motivation (only double degree applicants)
- \_ Short portfolio (only Textile Design applicants)

## Semester contribution

Studying as an exchange student at Hof University is free of charge. You only have to pay an **administrative fee** to the Student's Union of **approx. 125 €/semester** (subject to change). This fee allows e.g. for price reductions in the cafeteria and refectory and includes free public transportation in Hof and Münchberg.

## Visa requirements

The local German embassy gives information of visa requirements.

## Health insurance

The German government and the European Union have made it mandatory for all foreign students to have a <u>health insurance for the entire duration</u> of their studies.

Students from EU countries must present the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). It is essential that the insurance card is valid for the entire study period.

Students from Non-EU countries need to take out either a private health insurance that covers the entire study period or a German statutory health insurance.

For enrollment, it is mandatory to obtain a health insurance from a German statutory health insurance provider or to take out a sufficient private health insurance which is approved by one of the German statutory health insurance companies.

## Orientation period

We offer an orientation period for all exchange students before the start of each semester. Students will meet the other internationals during several get-togethers and excursions in and around Hof. They will also be supported in administrative issues and be prepared for their semester at our university (timetable workshop, meeting the professors, campus tours,...).

Moreover, we provide intensive German language courses on different levels which are free of charge. Participation in our orientation program will guarantee a relaxed start before the actual lectures begin.

# Housing options and costs



## How to apply for a room

After students have been admitted by Hof University, they will receive information on the Housing application process. Every student can then choose his/her favorite type of accommodation via an online portal.

Exchange students from our partner institutions may either live

- \_ in one of our student dormitories in a single room with a private bathroom or
- \_ in a shared furnished flat in a single or a double room.

#### Accommodation costs approx. 350 - 550 EUR per month.

Please note: Rental contracts always run for a period of 6 or 12 months!

Winter semester:	September 1 to February 28
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Summer semester: March 1 to August 31



#### Living expenses

In comparison to other German cities, the living costs in Hof are rather moderate (especially regarding rent). In general, students should have approx. 800-900 € per month at their disposal for their cost of living.

If a visa is needed, a financial proof of currently approx. 900 EUR per month (= EUR 10,800 per year) is required by the embassy.

Approximate cost calculation:

_	Rent:	EUR 350 - 550 / month
_	Compulsory health insurance:	EUR 125 / month

\_ Food + personal expenditure: EUR 350 / month

#### Estimated total:

about EUR 800 - 1.000 / month
